GOOD REASONS TO VISIT

- As of 2024, visitors to the monument will get to observe the reconstruction of the northern spire.
- Delve into the history of France and its royalty.
- Admire the restored stained glass windows and the rose windows that bathe the monument in light.

The fates of the Basilica Cathedral of Saint-Denis - the first masterpiece of Gothic art - and French royalty are closely linked in that the former has become the burial place of the kings and queens of France.

It now houses over seventy carved funerary tombs, including those of Dagobert, Francis I, Catherine de' Medici and Louis XVI. A large-scale project aimed at restoring the monument to its original design is currently under way; from the traditional skills of the builders to modern digital technologies, the task of rebuilding the spire will provide a unique opportunity to share with the public.

DID YOU KNOW...?

The current outline of the Basilica Cathedral of Saint-Denis is missing its 90m-high spire, a masterpiece of Gothic art.


